

MIRAMAR FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS

Miramar Fire Department is a full service, all-risk Fire Department, providing state-of-the-art services such as Advanced Life Support (ALS), Emergency Medical Services (EMS), residential, commercial and wildland fire suppression, technical rescue services, hazardous materials safety, fire prevention code enforcement, public education, and community service. The members of the Miramar Fire Department are dedicated to providing for the safety and welfare of the Community through preservation of life, property and the environment.

Miramar Fire Department employs sixty-nine (69) personnel to accomplish its Mission. Staffing is provided for fire prevention, training, communications, and two (2) Fire Stations. The Department operates three (3) engine companies, two (2) medic-ambulances and a Chief Officer position from two (2) stations, 24-hours a day, 365 days a year. The department cross staffs a rescue truck, a water tender, two (2) brush trucks and a hazmat decon truck.

The Department serves a geographical area consisting of urban development interfacing with wildland areas and covers approximately 23,015 acres thirteen (13) miles north of downtown San Diego and four (4) miles east of the Pacific Ocean.
