## WASTE DISPOSAL PROCEDURES

In our attempt to keep Installation personnel informed on waste disposal and recycling procedures, the following information is provided:

**The MCAS Miramar Recycling Center:** Located at building 6310 has **resumed** the practice of electronic device collection and recycling.

**Government property should be disposed/recycled via DRMS. San Diego DRMS can be contacted at (619) 556-1049 for assistance.**

Organizations aboard MCAS Miramar should have no need to make garbage runs to the Miramar landfill. The installation has two 40 cu yd roll-off dumpsters located adjacent to building 8219, and one located at the west end of the parking lot serving hanger 6. These are for bulky non hazardous items, i.e. non treated wood. Please use them.

Placing large bulky items in the small dumpsters could cause damage to the garbage trucks, and may cause the dumpster not to be emptied.

Do not place recyclables in the dumpsters. Diversion of cardboard, scrap metal, plastics, paper and other recyclables is a DoD mandate. Not only is recycling good for the environment, it creates revenue for the Installation, and it's an order!
